

Powered Mobile Equipment (Forklift) Safety Accountability

This applies to all clients and event contractors who will be providing their own forklift operated by their own employee(s) and/or preferred contractor at the Edmonton Expo Centre.

Under the Alberta Occupational Health and Safety Act, Section 2 (Obligations of Employers, Workers, etc.) and the Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Code, Section 19 (Powered Mobile Equipment), the Edmonton EXPO Centre has a duty to ensure that workers, clients and event contractors (including subcontracted companies) in our facility are aware of their responsibilities and duties to safely operate a forklift.

Clients and event contractors must ensure:

- 1. The forklift has a durable and legible load rating chart that is readily available to the operator
- 2. The forklift has a valid third-party certificate of inspection and the manufacturer's specification for safe operation is followed
- 3. The forklift operator is qualified and has a valid training certificate. The operator's training ticket must always be available on-site
- 4. The forklift operator must wear a high visibility safety vest and steel-toe footwear
- 5. The forklift operator observes the proper speed limit, honks when passing through blind spots, has blinker lights on and uses a spotter as needed
- 6. Cell phone use is prohibited when operating and/or driving the equipment. The forklift operator must wear a seat belt at all times and operate without the influence of drugs and/or alcohol
